NEW FLA LAWS ABOUT FOSTER PROGRAM

CS/CS/HB 989 (2025) - Licensure of Family Foster

Homes

Requires DCF to adopt rules to streamline licensure application process for licensed foster parents who relocate within this state; requires such rules to include priority review of applications, expedited home studies & background checks, & recognition of prior foster parent training coursework.

Effective Date: October 1, 2025

SB 1620 — Baker Act Changes Senate Bill 1620 strengthens Florida's Baker Act, which allows a person to be involuntarily detained and examined if they may be having a mental health crisis and pose a danger to themselves or others.

The law requires that individual treatment plans for people under this act be reevaluated at least once every six months.

In addition, this law requires the state to prioritize licensing for short-term residential treatment facilities in underserved counties and high-need areas.

SB 584 — Housing Support

Senate Bill 584 expands housing access and support services for homeless students who are current or former foster youth.

Under this law, Florida state universities must work with the state to develop plans to prioritize the placement of these students in campus housing.
